

Fee Schedule and Explanation 2010/11 Season

- 1. Family Membership (non-refundable)** - \$90 per family (*Registering after July 5th*)
-\$50 per family (*Registering by July 5th*)

- Membership includes VPSC Cap and Shirt for each swimmer

- 2. Swim BC/Swimming Canada Registration** 15 & Over \$177
(non-refundable) 11 – 14 years old \$135
9 – 10 years old \$89
8 & Under \$69
Junior/Green/White \$32

SDC swimmers who are not competing pay \$32 and no entry fee deposit

- 3. Entry Fee Deposit** - Swimmers are responsible for the costs related to all events participated in. Away meets are pay as you go.

- 4. Family Volunteer Fee** – Pay once per family. Credits will be applied and reconciled at the end of the season. Credits do not carry over to next season

- 5. Monthly Swimming Fee** - The highest paying swimmer is 1st swimmer. Subsequent swimmers receive a discount on the swimming fee portion only.

- 6. Full Payment Discount** – For families paying in full the following discount will be made available (*this discount has already be included in your “Option B” payment*):

White, Green & Junior Dolphins: \$25 per swimmer discount

- 7. Outstanding Amounts** – All accounts must be in good standing before swimmers can be registered for the new season. Swimmers transferring from other BC Swim Clubs must have a transfer approved by that club before they can swim with another BC swim club Swimmers whose accounts are in arrears may be suspended from swimming until all outstanding amounts are paid in full.
